

Member suspended

CHENG Chak Ho, MHKIS 2764, GP

The Disciplinary Board decided in its report dated 30 September 2003 the following charges against Mr. Cheng were established:

1. Mr. Cheng had deliberately or otherwise failed to disclose information relating to the listing on the GEM Board of a company to the senior management of his employing company;
2. Mr. Cheng should not have accepted or should not have accepted on behalf of his employing company instruction in connection with the listing of a company given that Mr. Cheng had interest or shareholding in that company and/ or Mr. Cheng was a director of that company at all material time.

In accordance with Part VI of the Bye-Laws, the General Council at its meeting on 20 November 2003, having duly considered the decision made by the Disciplinary Board determined that Mr. Cheng Chak Ho, MHKIS 2764, GP had conducted himself in a manner unbecoming a member of the Institute, contravening the Standard of Conduct and exercised its disciplinary power under rule 2.1.3 to suspend Mr. Cheng's membership of the Hong Kong Institute of Surveyors for a period of two years, effective from 25 November 2003.
